### **Data Standards**

Following the initial overview of programmatic demographic data collection, we identified a pressing need for robust demographic data standards within CalHHS. To address this, we actively engaged with the CalHHS Data Standards Community and other Agency data experts to develop race and ethnicity data collection standards.

These race and ethnicity standards serve to establish a benchmark for equitable data practices throughout CalHHS and will assist departments with creating their demographic data collection standards. We kindly request your feedback on these proposed standards, how you envision them being utilized, and any input on the next steps for the subcommittee's involvement.

### **Data Quality Report**

In our quest to build the Equity Dashboard, we delved deep into understanding departmental demographic data. This started with understanding the current state of demographic data collection and determining the overall goal of the Equity Dashboard. This comprehensive report details the lessons learned while creating the first iteration of the demographic data dashboard and will aid future data products and iterations of the dashboard. The Data Quality Report not only highlights our journey but also serves as a guidepost for maintaining data integrity and improving usability.

### **Proposed Public Release of Strategic Priorities and Impact Goals**
